

The Calgary Transit Senior Citizen Transit Pass provides unlimited access to Calgary Transit services (except Access Calgary) for all seniors 65 years of age and over. The Senior Citizen Transit Pass is a yearly pass that is valid each year from July 1 to June 30 of the following year.

## Eligibility Requirements

**Price \$35.00**

### Calgary Resident:

- Individuals must be a resident of Calgary. Proof of Calgary address must be presented at time of application. Examples are: current Alberta Driver's Licence or Alberta Government identification card, or a Utility bill with applicant's name, Calgary street address and postal code. Please note that P.O. Boxes and Rural Route addresses will not be accepted as proof of Calgary residency.

### Proof of Age:

- Individuals must provide proof of age at the time of purchase
- Individuals submitting their application by mail must include a **photocopy** of their proof of age

Any ONE of the following current documents is an acceptable source for determining age.

- Birth Certificate
- Driver's Licence
- Alberta Government Identification Card
- Baptismal Certificate
- Passport
- Alberta Health Care Card

## Reduced Rate Price: \$15.00

To be eligible to receive the Senior Citizen Transit Pass for the reduced rate of \$15.00, you must meet the minimum income requirements as noted below. You must provide proof of income when you apply for your pass. If married, proof of income for **both** spouses is required. Bring one of the following documents when applying in person or provide a photocopy if you submit your application by mail along with photocopies of the Eligibility Requirement documents listed on the reverse.

### Proof of Income Required to Qualify for Reduced Price:

- Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)
- Revenue Canada Income Tax - Notice of Assessment (Line 150). The maximum income you can earn based on your 2010 Total Income is \$18,745.00 for a single person or \$28,530.00 for a couple.
- T4A (OAS) Old Age Security (with dollar amount showing in Box 21)
- AISH Statement (Health Benefits Card)

NOTE: Individuals who receive the Alberta Senior's Benefit but do not qualify for GIS, or those who receive the Allowance for the Survivor Benefit, are not eligible for the reduced rate and must pay \$35.00.

### Payment Options for New Applicants:

- 1) Complete the application and forward it with a cheque or money order, made payable to Calgary Transit, to the address below. Please include photocopies **ONLY** of eligibility documents. Original documents will **NOT** be returned.
