Terms of Reference

North Central LRT Vision

Develop a plan for North Central LRT that follows The City's Sustainable Approach and positively impacts: community well-being; economy; environment; and smart growth and mobility.

COMMITTEE MISSION

To provide Calgary Transit feedback on the study findings throughout the planning process; to share neighbourhood concerns; and be a sounding board to possible solutions.

OBJECTIVES

1. Review options according to community priorities and the sustainability principles
2. Help prioritize values, and
3. To provide feedback on The City's proposed route options and approach.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

The Committee will consist of 15 representatives from north central Calgary communities. Representatives of other organizations will be invited to attend meetings to give the committee information on specific topics.

PARTICIPATION

- The Committee will meet approximately monthly on Wednesday evenings starting in the fall.
- Meetings will be held after business hours.
- Correspondence will be by electronic mail.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Consider all Calgarians when providing information about transit issues
2. Attend all Committee meetings
3. Be a regular transit user
4. Respond to any business matters sent by electronic mail within 72 hours
