

Calgary Transit Travel Training Summer Camp

The 'Get on Board' Travel Training Summer Camp aims to teach participants with disabilities how to safely and independently use Calgary Transit. It provides hands-on learning on Calgary Transit bus and CTrain. In order to ensure that this camp is right for you and your child please refer to the camp themes and below prerequisites.

Introduction to Calgary Transit - Preferred Prerequisites

- Be unfamiliar with riding Calgary Transit independently; some exposure is acceptable.
- Have a mild to moderate disability.
- Be between the ages of 12 18.
- Have the ability to recognize some words related to Calgary Transit. For example, help button, station, numbers, etc

Independent Travelers Camp - Preferred Prerequisites

- Attend the camp to gain sufficient knowledge on how to take Calgary Transit independently upon successful completion of the program.
- Have a mild to moderate disability.
- Be between the ages of 15 21.
- Have the ability to recognize numbers, read maps and tell/read time.
